**PETITION FOR REHEARING OF AN ORDER DENYING A PETITION FOR A WRIT OF CERTIORARI**

COMES NOW, Petitioner, Derrick Jerome Spencer proceeding pro se, and hereby respectfully submits this petition for rehearing on the following grounds:

I. This Court, on June 27th, 2022, decided *Concepcion v. United States*, No. 20-1650 (S. Ct. June 27, 2022).

Petitioner has several *Concepcion* issues that weren't addressed in petitioner's First Step Act proceedings, such as: recalculation of the sentencing guidelines consistent with the Fair Sentencing Act changes, and the applicability of Section 401 of the First Step Act.

II. The Court of first instance lacked jurisdiction over the petitioner. Specifically, Assistant United States Attorney Jeffrey S. Paulsen committed fraud upon the court, proceeding to trial with a criminal complaint disguised as a "true bill." The petitioner was never indicted by a Grand Jury, contrary to the Constitution and laws of the United States.

There is no lawful conviction nor sentence because the district court lacked jurisdiction to try and punish. See *Ex parte Bain*, 121 U.S. 1, 7 S. Ct. 781 (1887).

The complaint/indictment should've been dismissed under 18 U.S.C.S. 3367; Fed. R. Crim. P. 48.


**CONCLUSION**
