**AFFIDAVIT OF HELEN TYNE MAYFIELD IN SUPPORT OF HER INFORMA PAUPERIS
AFFIDAVIT**

Before me, the undersigned notary, on this day personally appeared Helen T. Mayfield, the affiant, a person whose identity is well known to me. After I administered an oath to affiant, testified:


1. I am 74 years and unemployed.
2. I have been unemployed since I was unable to begin employment with the federal government on a job that I had accepted in San Antonio and Fort Hood, Texas in 2007.
3. I have suffered two TIA's.
4. Since my home was searched by the College Station Police, approximately \$57,72,00.00 in a cashier's check in the amount of \$4,100.00, \$40,000.00 check that my bank had verified as good, \$12,000.00 in gold and silver and receivables were seized and not returned as well as all of my legal files and records without a court order or my consent as required by law, all personal and business records, State Bar files for licensure from the States of Texas, Michigan, and Illinois. None of these files and funds have been returned.
5. Lt. Arnold in sworn testimony on the record reported that "we had been engaging in warrantless searches of Miss Mayfield's townhouse because she had never been convicted of anything except an unpaid parking ticket." He testified on the record that my home had been searched without a warrant for weeks before the warrant was issued because "we needed to find enough evidence to support a warrant." All evidence in my trial except 12 checks were obtained in warrantless searches of my townhouse.
6. Since my arrest and release, I have been stalked by the College Station Police and a Federal Task Force and my home has been searched for 14 years by them without a warrant.
7. My home is searched and legal documents seized by someone. Court documents are altered in all of my cases by someone.

8. I receive Social Security at a reduced rate because of my health and legal issues and a small pension and I lost two pensions from an Enron type scam and Bank One lost one pension in two months without any withdrawals on my part.
9. All documents in my initial Writ of Habeas were altered in every court including this court such that my case has never been reviewed by any court.
10. No trial transcript has ever existed of my trial or one has never been presented to me that has not been substantially altered and complete enough for me to appeal all of my issues
11. Someone continues to stalk me daily and break into my home and seize documents that I store with friends, law professors, churches and safe deposits of Capitol One Bank and State Bank of Texas have been robbed. The U.S. District Court of the Southern District, Fifth Circuit and this Court have had documents that I filed altered by someone.
