Declaration In Support Of
Motion For An Extension Of Time To File Petition For A Writ Of Certiorari

I, *Rufus Lamar Savin Spearman, hereinafter, also referred to as either me, my, myself, and I make this declaration in support of my motion for an extension of time to file petition for a writ of certiorari, and do hereby state the following:

1. On or about January 05, 2022, Circuit Judges, Karen Nelson Moore, Ronald Lee Gilman, and Raymond M. Hathledge, of the United States Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit, denied my petition for rehearing en banc, and also denied my motion for the appointment of counsel.

2. Because I am being unlawfully detained as a prisoner by the Defendants I am suing, and because they have and continue to exploit my unlawful detainment by retaliating against me for seeking redress of the violation of, or enforcement of my rights, it is a real possibility I will not be able to thoroughly research, prepare, and submit my petition

for a writ of certiorari by the April 05, 2022, filing deadline.

3. Furthermore, despite my multiple motions for temporary restraining orders / preliminary injunctions, see, *Spearman vs. Michigan*, 2020 U.S. App. LEXIS 40577 (6th Cir. 2020); *Spearman vs. Heyns*, 2019 U.S. App. LEXIS 2335 (6th Cir. 2019); and *Spearman vs. Williams*, 1:17-cv-1070 (U.S. Mich. 2020), ECF Num. 84, the MDOC staff are actually influencing and encouraging inmates to spy on surveillance me and then disrupt and harass me from being able to effectively engage in litigious activities.

4. Examples of the disruptive and harassing behaviors include: excessive yelling "pointlessly" for extended periods of time, intentionally interrupting my sleep at night, and making veiled threats of violence that creates a negatively charged environment.

5. Moreover, on or about December 02, 2021, I was forced to seek this facility's administration's assistance because officers began issuing me false misconduct reports in retaliation for my multiple Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA) complaints because officers were sexually abusing me. [Refer, SLF-21-11-973-17C; SLF-21-11-924-17C; **SLF-21-08-688-17A**]. In response to coming forward and addressing these problems and seeking this administration's help I was issued another misconduct report, and then two additional misconduct reports when I refused to return to the situation. I, have been being held in detention-like segregated confinement since December 02, 2021. And, the law library here refuses to provide any caselaw materials, access to the 'Electronic Law Library', and will not permit me to meet and discuss legal issues with the legal writer prior to turning over my legal documents. 6. I, am making this motion now because I fear getting to the filing date and then having to do so, which might burden the court's schedule unnecessarily.

7. I, respectfully request this motion be granted in all respects for the reasons stated herein.
