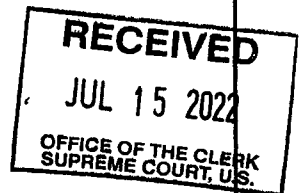

1. I, ~~Rufus~~ Rufus Lamar Davis Spearman, including any and all derivations; and/or variations in spelling, hereinafter, also referred to as either me, my, myself, and/or I, also as the Petitioner, am a Multiracial African American, 42 year young, single, heterosexual, Male being unlawfully detained as a prisoner by the State of Michigan and MSOC, and am proceeding with this 'Petition for a Rehearing' Pursuant to Rules 39 and 44(2), Rules of the Supreme Court of the United States (U.S. Sup. Ct. R.), without the assistance of a lawyer, counsel, or attorney.

Factual Case Summary

2. On or about April 06, 2022, I filed a petition for a writ of certiorari presenting nine questions for review, which stemmed from the Defendants intentional misrepresentation of information, fabrication of facts, and documents to have me involuntarily admitted into their CMHP and medicated with antipsychotic drugs.

3. In my reasons for granting the petition for a writ of certiorari I asserted that the lower courts had refused or failed to consider certain claims, that the lower courts' decisions conflicted with the decisions of other courts, and briefly expounded upon the importance of the questions presented.

4. On or about June 13, 2022, this court denied my petition for a writ of certiorari. I, am now respectfully requesting a rehearing because other substantial grounds exist that were not previously presented.

Argument

Point One - A rehearing of the order denying my petition for a writ of certiorari should be granted because the Defendants have been engaged in a pattern of unlawfully involuntarily medicating prisoners.

5. Since the filing of my petition for a writ of certiorari, I have discovered the existence of other substantial grounds which were not previously presented that warrants a rehearing.

6. After being transferred to ECF on or about May 03, 2022, on or about May 13, 2022, I was assigned to 218: Unit 4. Michael Lresham, Identification Number: 272603, was assigned to 205: Unit 4, which was located directly across from me. Michael, AKA "Money Mike", confided in me by explaining that he too had been involuntarily paroled and committed to the MBOE's UHP, and subsequently forcibly medicated, in retaliation for his religious activities. Unlike me, however, where I have no history of violent or assaultive behavior in relation to any mental illness, Money Mike does. Regardless of such, the UHP of the MBOE and State of Michigan should not be allowed to utilize the UHP and antipsychotic drugs as a weapon against prisoners that exercise their constitutional and federal rights when the prisoners complain of unlawful treatment or conditions. Yet, this is exactly what has been occurring. Money Mike was even willing to perfect an affidavit attesting to, inter alia, these facts but the C.O.'s (P.C. Bennett, and Officer Luomolo) said that passing is prohibited for prisoners and them regardless of the item or its use.

7. My acquaintance with Money Mike brings to my mind an acquaintance I developed with Abu Sabach, Identification Number: 978339, while I was being housed at the Woodland Center Correctional Facility's (WCC) Crisis Stabilization Unit. Abu confided in me and explained that he was a foreign exchange student here in Michigan, U.S.A., but that he is originally from Cote D'Ivoire, Africa. He explained to me that after arriving to one of the MDOL's facilities, he was attacked by one or more inmates attempting to take property from him and was stabbed multiple times. He sought medical attention for his injuries and when questioned about their cause honestly responded. He said that healthcare staff and MDOL staff instructed him to meet with mental health staff, and then involuntarily paroled and committed him to the CMHP, where he was subsequently involuntarily medicated. See 2:18-cv-10673-NGE-DHG, ECF Num. 1-1, Page ID. 160. He said that he made no threats of harming himself, others, or property, but was still forced into the CMHP and drugged.

Conclusion

8. I respectfully request the denial of my petition for a writ of certiorari be overturned, a lawyer be appointed to aid and assist me as counsel, and my petition granted in light of the aforementioned reasons.
