**O R D E R**

---

Jamie Allen seeks to appeal his 120-month sentence imposed following his guilty plea to conspiracy to possess with intent to distribute methamphetamine and heroin, in violation of 21 U.S.C. §§ 841(a)(1), (b)(1)(A), 846. The Government has moved to dismiss the appeal as barred by Allen's waiver of the right to appeal included in the plea agreement. Upon review of the record, we conclude that Allen knowingly and voluntarily waived his right to appeal and that the issue Allen seeks to raise on appeal falls squarely within the scope of his waiver of appellate rights. Accordingly, we grant the Government's motion to dismiss.
