NOW COMES, Petitioner, Mark Winger, pursuant to the rules of the Supreme Court of the United States, Rule 44.6, and the Clerk of the Court's letter dated July 11, 2022, presents the following corrected Petition for Rehearing of the Court's May 23, 2022 decision denying his pro se Petition for Writ of Certiorari on the following grounds:


Grounds: Petitioner's constitutional right to Due process of law under the 5th and 14th amendments to the United States Constitution were violated when the Illinois Appellate Court applied the Bagley standard in making its determination that newly discovered evidence in Petitioner's Brady claim was not material and dismissed the Brady claim. However, Petitioner's newly discovered evidence, fraudulently concealed by the State, supported his allegation that prosecutors knowingly relied on false police testimony at trial to obtain a conviction against Petitioner. Thus, the Illinois Appellate Court should have evaluated Petitioner's

Brady claim pursuant to clearly established law set forth in cases Napue v. Illinois, Kyles v. Whitley, Strickler v. Green, and their progeny. The relevant facts and grounds for certiorari were well-pleaded in Petitioner's Petition for Writ of Certiorari. ¹

WHEREFORE, Petitioner prays that the Honorable Court will reconsider its decision denying his Petition for Writ of Certiorari and allow his Petition to proceed further.


