


Dear Mr. Kimbrough:

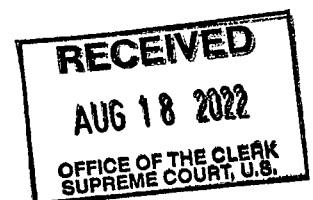
You must also certify that the petition for rehearing is presented in good faith and not for delay.
