Pursuant to Rule 30.4 and your February 2020 Memorandum Concerning Deadlines for Cert Stage Pleadings and The Scheduling of Cases for Conference, I am writing on behalf of Respondents Brenda Davis and Fred Stufflebean to request a 30-day extension of time to file a brief in opposition to the Petition for Writ of Certiorari filed with the Court on behalf of Michelle Munger, et al. on November 19, 2021 and docketed on November 24, 2021.
