**PETITIONER'S APPLICATION TO PROCEED IN FORMA
PAUPERIS**

Petitioner Levi Miller, who is serving a sentence in prison, asks leave to file his Petition for a Writ of Certiorari to the United States Court of Appeals for the Eighth Circuit without prepayment of filing fees or costs and to proceed *in forma pauperis*. This request is made pursuant to Rule 39(1), Supreme Court Rules.

Petitioner requested, under the Criminal Justice Act, on the authority of 18 USC § 3006A, and was granted appointed counsel at the trial in district court and on appeal from his sentence. A copy of the order appointing counsel on appeal is attached. Therefore, Petitioner also asks leave to proceed *in forma pauperis* without filing a notarized affidavit or declaration of indigence.
