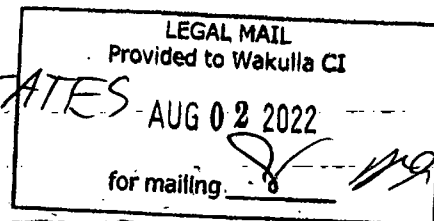

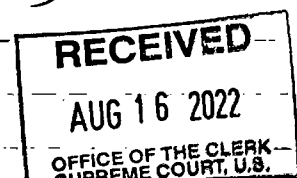

PETITION FOR REHEARING
(Second Amended Petition)

COMES NOW William James Siskos, In Good Faith as a Federal adjudged Mentally disabled U.S. Citizen with no accommodation to secure communications are effective as others, pro se, To Petition for REHEARING under intervening circumstances of objectively obvious outright discriminatory denial of due process meaningful opportunity to be heard in Violation of Constitutional fourteenth Amendment and international Universal Declaration of Human Rights Articles to include but not limited to Five, Six, seven, Eight, Nine, and Article Ten.

In support of rehearing Petitioner presents The following Certificate of sworn affidavit briefly and distinctly stating grounds and stating grounds are limited to intervening circumstances of substantial or controlling effect.



1. It is clear on the face of record that Siskos did not receive any fair hearing at both state and Federal level by clear and convincing evidence provided in his Rule 60 Motion. This includes no Magistrate Judge review or recommendations to allow Petitioner opportunity to dispute incorrect false Material legal standards and facts. The State agents knew or should of known were false.
2. Petitioner then presented Rule 60 (b)(3) to expose fraud, misrepresentation and Fraud by state agents and despite clear and convincing evidence of plain error it was dismissed without proper review as due process requires.
3. The Fourteenth Amendment to the Constitution due process guarantees a meaningful opportunity to be heard and has substantiated or controlling intervening effects under circumstances of outright denial of meaningful opportunity to be heard as in this case Siskos has demonstrated by clear and convincing evidence.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner prays That this honorable court will grant Rehearing and allow Petitioner a meaningful opportunity to be heard and correct the plain error made on false premiss the state agents presented to federal court That they knew or should of known were false and provide all relief Siskos is entitled to for violations of his Constitutional Rights and International law guarantees
