APPLICATION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME WITHIN WHICH  
TO FILE PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI

TO THE HONORABLE JOHN G. ROBERTS, JR., CHIEF JUSTICE OF THE  
UNITED STATES AND CIRCUIT JUSTICE FOR THE DISTRICT OF  
COLUMBIA CIRCUIT

Petitioner Lonnell Tucker requests an extension of time of thirty (30) days to file his Petition for Writ of Certiorari. The current deadline for filing the Petition for Writ of Certiorari is April 13, 2022. This application is being filed more than ten days prior to the due date. A copy of the opinion below is appended to this application. This Court's jurisdiction is invoked pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1254(1).

This petition presents an important question interpreting the standard of review of the methodology used to determine relevant conduct in narcotics sentencing, decided adversely to Petitioner below, in which the District of Columbia Circuit stands in conflict with opinions of several circuit courts of

appeals. *See United States v Tucker*, 12 F.4th 804 (D.C. Cir. 2021) slip op. at 8-11, *reh'g denied sub nom. United States v. Fields*, No. 19-3043 (D.C. Cir. Jan. 13, 2022).

An extension of time is required because of the press of other cases, including engagements with clients on time-sensitive matters requiring counsel's current and immediate attention. No party will suffer prejudice from granting this application.
