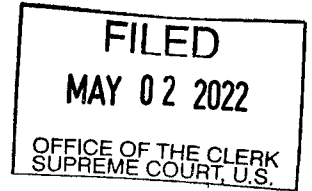

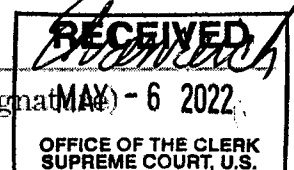

**AFFIDAVIT OR DECLARATION
