PER CURIAM:

Richard Coleman appeals the district court's order dismissing his civil action without prejudice for improper venue.* We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. *Coleman v. State of North Carolina*, No. 2:21-cv-00399-RAJ-LRL (E.D. Va. Sept. 27, 2021). We dispense with oral argument because the facts and legal contentions are adequately presented in the materials before this court and argument would not aid the decisional process.

AFFIRMED

* We conclude that the district court's order dismissing Coleman's action without prejudice is an appealable final order. *See Domino Sugar Corp. v. Sugar Workers Local Union* 392, 10 F.3d 1064, 1067 (4th Cir. 1993) (holding that dismissal without prejudice may be final if no amendment to complaint can cure defect in plaintiff's complaint).

DISMISSAL ORDER

Plaintiff Richard Coleman (“Plaintiff”), appearing *pro se*, submitted an Application to Proceed in District Court Without Prepaying Fees or Costs (“IFP Application”),¹ along with a proposed Complaint. IFP Appl., ECF No. 1; Proposed Compl., ECF No. 1-1. Based on the information contained in Plaintiff’s IFP Application, the Court is satisfied that Plaintiff qualifies for *in forma pauperis* status. Accordingly, Plaintiff’s IFP Application, ECF No. 1, is GRANTED, and the Clerk is DIRECTED to file Plaintiff’s Complaint. However, for the reasons set forth below, this action is hereby DISMISSED without prejudice.

I. Background

In his Complaint, Plaintiff identifies the named Defendants as: (i) the State of North Carolina; (ii) Franklin County, North Carolina; (iii) the Honorable Amanda Stevenson (“Judge Stevenson”), a state court judge from North Carolina; (iv) Arkofa Auto Sales (“Arkofa”), a car dealership in North Carolina; and (v) R. Keith Shackelford (“Mr. Shackelford”), an attorney from North Carolina (collectively “Defendants”). Compl. at 1-20. In the “Statement of the Case”

¹ When a party proceeds in district court without prepaying fees or costs, it is said that the party is proceeding *in forma pauperis*. As such, the Court will refer to Plaintiff’s fee waiver application as an “IFP Application.”

section of his Complaint, Plaintiff alleges that Arkofa listed a 1997 Honda Odyssey for sale on Craig's List on October 19, 2019. *Id.* at 3. Plaintiff, who was living in Chapel Hill, North Carolina at the time, drove to Arkofa to purchase the vehicle. *Id.* at 3-4. Plaintiff alleges that on the drive home:

the engine smoked as if oil had leaked on top on the block, the engine gauge read maximum, [the vehicle was] overheating, the gas gauge recorded "empty," neither the speedometer or odometer functioned, the overhead moon window leaked when it rained, the handle on the side door was broken, and the rear door could not be locked or unlocked from outside the vehicle.

Id. at 4. Plaintiff alleges that a "local [i]nspection [s]tation" advised him that "it would cost \$4,585.00 to make the necessary repairs." *Id.* Plaintiff alleges that he contacted an agent of Arkofa to complain about the vehicle's defects and to demand a full refund; however, Arkofa "refused to do either." *Id.*

Plaintiff alleges that on March 1, 2020, he filed a lawsuit against Arkofa in a North Carolina state court, and asserted claims of fraud and deceptive business practices. *Id.* Plaintiff alleges that Arkofa, who was represented by Mr. Shackelford, filed an untimely dismissal motion. *Id.* at 4-5. The North Carolina court scheduled a status hearing for January 11, 2021; however, Plaintiff alleges that Arkofa, Mr. Shackelford, and the presiding judge, Judge Stevenson, conspired to, among other things: (i) hold a trial on the date of the status hearing; (ii) ignore certain pleadings filed by Plaintiff; (iii) ignore Plaintiff's request for a jury trial; (iv) accept improper witness testimony; (v) dismiss Plaintiff's lawsuit; and (vi) withhold the dismissal order from Plaintiff until Plaintiff's deadline to appeal expired. *Id.* at 6-8.

Based on these factual allegations, Plaintiff filed the instant action in this Court, and asserts claims against Arkofa, Mr. Shackelford, Judge Stevenson, the State of North Carolina, and/or Franklin County, North Carolina for fraud, deceptive business practices, the violation of Plaintiff's rights under the North Carolina State Constitution, the violation of Plaintiff's rights under the

Fourteenth Amendment to the United States Constitution, and the violation of the Racketeer Influenced and Corrupt Organizations Act. *Id.* at 9-20.

II. Venue Issues

Upon review of Plaintiff's Complaint, it is clear that venue is improper in this Court.

Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1391(b), the general venue statute, a civil action may be brought in:

- (1) a judicial district in which any defendant resides, if all defendants are residents of the State in which the district is located;
- (2) a judicial district in which a substantial part of the events or omissions giving rise to the claim occurred, or a substantial part of property that is the subject of the action is situated; or
- (3) if there is no district in which an action may otherwise be brought as provided in this section, any judicial district in which any defendant is subject to the court's personal jurisdiction with respect to such action.

28 U.S.C. § 1391(b).

Here, Plaintiff's lawsuit is based on (i) an alleged fraudulent vehicle sale that took place in North Carolina; and (ii) the manner in which Plaintiff was treated by Defendants during a subsequent lawsuit that Plaintiff filed in a North Carolina state court. Compl. at 1-20. Defendants in the instant action are residents of North Carolina, not Virginia, and all of the events giving rise to Plaintiff's claims allegedly occurred in North Carolina. Accordingly, venue is improper in this Court.

When venue is improper, 28 U.S.C. § 1406(a) directs the Court to "dismiss, or if it be in the interest of justice, transfer such case to any district or division in which it could have been brought." 28 U.S.C. § 1406(a); *see Coleman v. North Carolina*, No. 2:20cv350, 2020 U.S. Dist. LEXIS 154083, at *1-4 (E.D. Va. July 27, 2020) (dismissing a previous lawsuit filed by Plaintiff against North Carolina, a county in North Carolina, state court judges from North Carolina, and a clerk from a North Carolina state court, after determining that venue was

improper and that a transfer was not "in the interest of justice"), *aff'd*, 841 F. App'x 589 (4th Cir. Mar. 26, 2021). Here, the Court finds that it is not "in the interest of justice" to transfer this case to another district. Instead, this action should be dismissed without prejudice.

III. Conclusion

For the reasons set forth above, Plaintiff's IFP Application, ECF No. 1, is **GRANTED**; the Clerk is **DIRECTED** to file Plaintiff's Complaint; and this action is hereby **DISMISSED** without prejudice.

Plaintiff may appeal this Dismissal Order by forwarding a written notice of appeal to the Clerk of the United States District Court, Norfolk Division, 600 Granby Street, Norfolk, Virginia 23510. The written notice must be received by the Clerk within thirty days from the date of entry of this Dismissal Order.

In addition to the instructions listed above, the Clerk is **DIRECTED** to send a copy of this Dismissal Order to Plaintiff.


