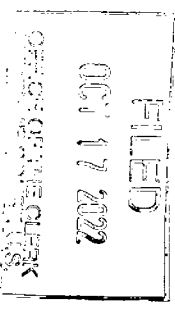

PETITION FOR A REHEARING ON PETITION
FOR A WRIT OF CERTIORARI

COMES now the Petitioner, Antonio D. McCaster (who is presently incarcerated at the Indiana State Prison with D.O.C. # 242478), proceeding, pro se, and in good faith submits this Petition For A Rehearing On Petition For A Writ Certiorari, to this Honorable Court, And in doing so states the following reasons,

1) The date of the Petitioner's Petition For A Writ of Certiorari was filed on March 18, 2022 and placed on the docket May 24, 2022, as No: 21-7953.
