I am counsel of record for a group of respondents in the above-captioned case: Goodwin Hospice, LLC; Phoenix Hospice, Inc.; International Tutoring Services, LLC; Curo Health Services, LLC; and Hospice Plus, LP. This case is currently pending before the Court on a petition for a writ of certiorari, which was filed on November 24, 2021 and placed on the docket on November 30, 2021. On January 19, 2022, the Court requested a response to the petition and set an initial deadline of February 18, 2022.

In accordance with this Court's Rule 30.4, I respectfully request a 14-day extension of time for all respondents to file a response, to and including March 4, 2022.
