**ORDER REGARDING MOTION TO PROCEED *IN FORMA
PAUPERIS***

The complaint by Plaintiff Michael G. Peters was dismissed as barred by the three-strikes provision of 28 USC § 1915(g). Dkt 3. He has filed a notice of appeal. Dkt 7. He has also filed a request to proceed *in forma pauperis* on appeal. Dkt 8. He submitted with that application his trust fund information certified by an institutional officer. Dkt 9.

The request by Peters for leave to proceed *in forma pauperis* on appeal under 28 USC § 1915 is DENIED. Dkt 8. The “three strikes” rule of § 1915(g) bars him from proceeding *in forma pauperis* on appeal.

It is ORDERED that:

- Peters must pay the entire appellate filing fee of \$505 within thirty days of this Order.
- The Clerk is directed not to file the Appellant’s Notice of Appeal until he pays the entire appellate filing fee of \$505.


