The Court granted the petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned case on May 2, 2022. Under the Court's rules, petitioner's opening brief on the merits is currently due June 16, 2022.

Because of scheduling conflicts created by ongoing litigation matters, the parties jointly request a 30-day extension of the deadlines to file both petitioner's opening brief and the joint appendix and respondent's merits brief. This extension (which we request pursuant to Rules 25.5 and 30.4 of the Rules of this Court) would result in the following schedule (subject to the Court's approval):
