Dear Mr. Harris:

The petition for a writ of certiorari in this case was filed on May 30, 2022, and placed on the Court’s docket on June 10, 2022. The government’s response is currently due, on one extension, on October 3, 2022.

We respectfully request, under Rule 30.4 of the Rules of this Court, a further extension to and including November 2, 2022, within which to file the government’s response. This extension is necessary because the attorneys with principal responsibility for final preparation of the government’s response have been heavily engaged with the press of other matters before the Court.
