Dear Mr. Hudson:

The application for an extension of time within which to file a petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-entitled case was originally postmarked June 22, 2021 and received again on February 15, 2022. The application is returned for the following reason(s):

On March 19, 2020, the Court extended the deadline to file petitions for writs of certiorari in all cases due on or after the date of that order to 150 days from the date of the lower court judgment, order denying discretionary review, or order denying a timely petition for rehearing. This is the maximum extension allowed by statute and rule, so the Court will not docket extension requests with respect to cert petitions covered by this order.

During the period in which you submitted your extension of time, the Court was not docketing extensions of time due to the Court's order of March 19, 2020. 3 2. Petitioner's petition for writ of habeas corpus is denied;


4 3. The clerk of court close this case; and

On Friday April 30, 2021, you Inmate Hudson, Jordan (BB8017 205-33U) are being transferred from the California Rehabilitation Center (CRC) to California Institution for Men. (CIM)/Facility B and being placed in Administrative Segregation Unit (ASU) Higher Custody for Enemy/Safety concerns at CRC.

On Friday April 30, 2021, at approximately 1330 hours, a confidential source (CS) indicated that you were a subject for assault by multiple Inmates at CRC. CS state you're multiple encounters with custody staff for your refusal to program and go to your assigned job has brought unwanted attention to your Dorm. Additionally the CS indicates Inmates in your Dorm that are participating in illegal activities feel the attention you are getting by custody staff will bring unwanted searches to your Dorm. (Refer to 1030 authored by Correctional Sergeant J. Robles).

Therefore, based on the aforementioned information, your presence jeopardizes the safety and security of the institution and unsuitable for open dorm housing at CRC NDPF

Per CCR Title 15, Section 3272, your custody level will increase to Maximum Custody as a result of this placement. Your visiting, canteen, and exercise privileges will be adjusted to be consistent with your new custody status.

You will remain in Higher Custody pending administrative review for appropriate housing and program needs. The CRC Institution Classification Committee will see you within 10 days of this transfer.

You are not identified as a participant in the Mental Health Services Delivery System at any level of care. Your T.A.B.E score is above 4.0.
