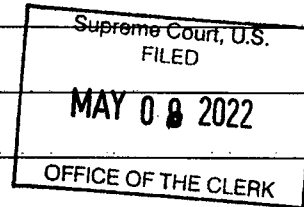

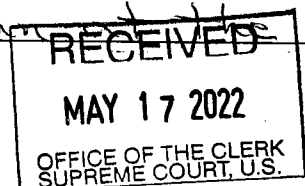

FOR 30-DAY EXTENSION
OF TIME TO FILE PETITION
FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI

Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30 (which petitioner does not have access to), petitioner John L. Miller requests a 30-day extension of the May 26, 2022 deadline for him to file a Petition for Writ of Certiorari in the above-entitled action, to and including June 27, 2022.

The grounds for this request are:
1. being a layman, petitioner didn't know that the 90 days within which for him to file the petition began at the

10 3. petitioner's ability to do legal
11 research and get photocopies made
12 is restricted to his Facility's library,
13 and it has been closed for at least
14 the past ten days, nor does petitioner
15 know when it will reopen;

16 4. due to the library's not being
17 open, petitioner is unable to get any
18 photocopies made, even of this
19 Application, and so has made a copy
20 by hand for service on respondents'
21 counsel, minus Exhibit A (mandate).
