To the Clerk of the Court:

We represent Respondent CRST Expedited, Inc. in the case referenced above. Petitioners Cathy Sellars et al. filed their petition for a writ of certiorari on December 6, 2021, and this matter was placed on the docket on December 8, 2021. Respondent's brief in opposition to the petition is due on January 7, 2022. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30.4, we write to request a thirty (30) day extension of time to file a brief in opposition to the petition in this case.
