APPENDIX B

Fourteenth Amendment- All person born or nationalized in the United States and is subject to the jurisdiction thereof are citizens of the United States and of the State they resides. No State shall make or force any laws which shall abridge any privileges or immunity of citizens of the nor deny to any person within its jurisdiction the equal protection of the law of the .United States, nor shall any Ste deprive any person of life, liberty or property without due process of law

Fourth Amendment – Seizure to be conducted on upon issuance of a warrant jurisdictionally sanctioned by probable cause supported by an oath or affirmation particularly describing the place to be searched and the person or thing to be seized.

42 U.S.C.S 1985 and 1986 – If two or more persons conspire to prevent by force, intimidation, or threats, in the furtherance of such a conspiracy, where two or more persons conspired to go in disguise on the highway, or the premise thereof for the purpose of depriving, either directly or indirectly the equal protection of the law, or of equal privileges and immunities under the law; or for the purpose of preventing or hindering the constituted authorities within any State or Territory the equal protection of the law shall be liable for the action.
