I am counsel of record for the Respondents in this case. According to the online docket, Petitioner's Petition for a Writ of Certiorari was docketed on December 16, 2021, and pursuant to Rules 15.3 and 30 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of the United States, Respondents' Brief in Opposition is currently due on Tues, January 18, 2022. Pursuant to Rule 30.4, Respondents respectfully request that the time for filing their Brief in Opposition be extended by 30 days, to and including Thursday, February 17, 2022.

This is Respondents' first request for an extension of time to file a response. Good cause exists for the requested extension. I did not represent Respondents in this case in the district court or court of appeals, and thus require sufficient time to familiarize myself with the relevant legal issues and record.
