Please accept this letter as Respondent's Motion for Extension of Time to respond to Nahed Abdulnabi's Petition for Writ of Certiorari. We request this extension based on the following:

1. Original Petitioner, Nehad Abdelnabi, has requested that consideration of his Petition for Writ of Certiorari be delayed to be combined with the anticipated Petition for Writ of Certiorari from his brother relating to the same lower court order.
