As counsel of record for petitioner in the above-captioned case, I am writing to notify the Court that, pursuant to Rule 15.5, petitioner hereby waives the 14-day waiting period for the distribution of briefs in this case and requests that the certiorari petition and any other briefs filed in this case be distributed on February 2, 2022, for consideration at conference on February 18.

Respondents filed their brief in opposition on January 25, 2022, which, pursuant to Rule 15.5, ordinarily would result in a distribution date of February 9, for consideration at conference on February 25. Petitioner requests the distribution date of February 2 because the briefs in a related, companion case – *Musta v.
