15 Petitioner, Christopher Isaac Simmons, respectfully submits his First
16 Request for an Extension of Time to prepare and file his Petition for Writ of
17 Certiorari in this Court.

18 Petitioner was prevented from accessing the legal library due to the
19 access policy in place at the California Medical Facility (CMF) regarding a
20 "Priority Legal User (PLU) acting in "Pro Per" and having a "Court Deadline"
21 within 30 days, which prevented Petitioner from utilizing the first 60 days to
22 conduct meaningful research into the issues raised by Certiorari.

23 Additionally, because of the new COVID-19 Delta Strain, it is unclear
24 whether or not restrictions are being properly applied when permitting access
25 to those inmates without "court deadlines" who are preparing habeas corpus
26 writs concerning their criminal convictions.


27 Finally, Petitioner is not requesting this extension for any improper
