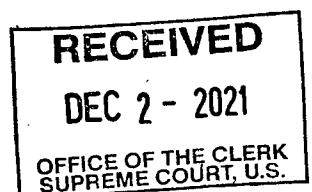

Petitioner, Christopher Coker, pro se, moves the Court for an Extension of Time of 90 days to file a Writ of Certiorari and represents:

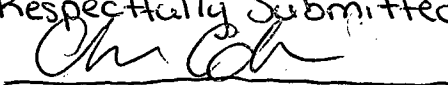
