I am the petitioner in this case. I filed a writ of certiorari on October 25, 2021. On December 6, 2021, my motion for leave to proceed in forma pauperis was denied and I was ordered to pay the docketing fee and submit a petition in compliance with Rule 33.1 of the Rules of this Court. This means reprinting in booklet format at considerable printing and shipping cost from hundreds to thousands of dollars, and the \$300 filing fee. Both are currently due on December 27.
