I am the petitioner in this case. I filed a writ of certiorari on October 25, 2021. On December 6, 2021, my motion for leave to proceed in forma pauperis was denied and I was ordered to by the docketing fee and submit a petition in compliance with Rule 33.1 of the Rules of this Court.
