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TO THE HONORABLE CLARENCE THOMAS,
Associate Justice of the Supreme Court of the United
States, and Circuit Justice for the United States Court of
Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit:

The Petitioner, KIRK L. FLOYD, through undersigned
counsel and pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2101 and Supreme
Court Rules 13.5 and 30.2, respectfully requests an
extension of time of sixty (60) days to file his Petition for
Writ of Certiorari in this Court. Mr. Floyd will seek review

of the decision of the United States Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit entered on December 14, 2021. Mr. Floyd invokes the jurisdiction of this Court pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1254. His time to file a Petition for Writ of Certiorari will expire on March 14, 2022. Mr. Floyd makes this application for an extension more than ten (10) days before the petition's original due date. This is his first request for an extension of time.

Counsel for Mr. Floyd asks the Court to extend that deadline for these reasons. First, counsel requires additional time to consult with other Supreme Court advocates about the petition. Second, counsel's work on other cases, including appeals in the Eleventh Circuit Court of Appeals, will prevent him from completing this certiorari petition on time.

CONCLUSION

Mr. Floyd asks this Court to extend time to file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari by sixty (60) days, until and including May 13, 2022.
