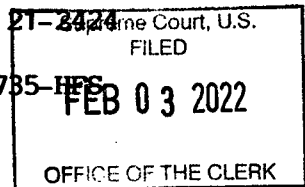

PETITIONER'S MOTION REQUESTING A SIXTY-DAY EXTENSION
OF TIME TO FILE WRIT OF CERTIORARI
WITH HIS SUGGESTIONS IN SUPPORT

COMES NOW Petitioner, Timothy McClendon, and requests a Justice of this Court, pursuant to S.Ct. Rule 30, grant him a sixty-day extension of time to file a Writ of Certiorari. And for his suggestions in support, states as follows.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

1. Petitioner filed a petition for a writ of habeas corpus with the U.S. District Court, for the Western District of Missouri, Case No. 4:20-CV-00735-HFS). The district court denied relief without issuing a certificate of appealability (COA).

2. Petitioner timely filed a notice of appeal and request for a COA with the United States Court of Appeals for the 8th Circuit. The court denied Petitioner's request for a COA, and he timely filed a motion for rehearing en banc and/or rehearing by the panel which was denied on January 5, 2022 (Petitioner's Exhibit A).

3. Petitioner's petition for a writ of certiorari is due to be filed with this Court on or before April 5, 2022.
