**Application for an Extension of Time Within
Which to File a Petition for a Writ of Certiorari to the Seventh
Circuit Court of Appeals**

To the Honorable Amy Coney Barrett, Justice of the United States Supreme Court and Circuit Justice to the Seventh Circuit:

1. Petitioner, Shellie Lewis, pursuant to Rule 13.5 of the Rules of this Court, respectfully seeks a sixty (60) day extension of time, up to and including to Monday, June 20, 2022, within which to file her petition for writ of certiorari in this Court.

2. The judgment for which review is sought is *Lewis v. Village of Alsip*, No. 21-2528, 23 F.4th 772 (7th Cir., January 19, 2022) (attached as Exhibit 1). The Seventh Circuit affirmed the district court's dismissal of the case.

3. This Court will have jurisdiction over any timely filed petition for certiorari in this case pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1254(1). Under Rules 13.1, 13.3, and

30.1 of the Rules of this Court, a petition for a writ of certiorari was due to be filed on or before April 19, 2022. In accordance with Rule 13.5, this application is being filed more than 10 days in advance of the filing date for the petition for a writ of certiorari.

4. The extension of time is necessary because of the press of other client business. In the coming months, Plaintiffs' counsel have a bench trial, scheduled for a week beginning, Monday, April 18, 2022, in *Frazier v. Baldwin*, No. 18-CV-1991 (United States District Court for the Northern District of Illinois, Eastern Division) (Feinerman, J.); an appellate opening brief due March 25, 2022, in *Orozco v. Dart*, No. 22-1194 (7th Cir.); and an appellate reply brief due April 14, 2022, in *Koch v. Hartland*, 22-1007 (7th Cir.)

For the foregoing reasons, the Petitioner respectfully requests that this Court grant an extension of sixty (60) days, up to and including Monday, June 20, 2022, within which to file her petition for writ of certiorari.
