a timely writ of certiorari

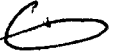

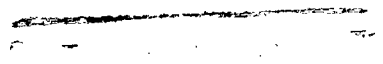

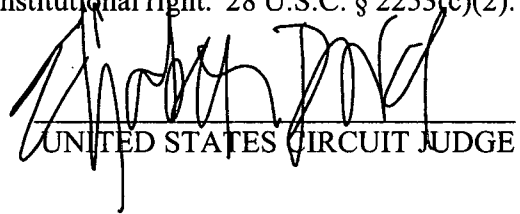
