Re: Renewed application for a COA to Justice Gorsuch

Dear Clerk,

I hereby renew my application for a Certificate of Appealability (COA) under Supreme Court Rule 22.4. Justice Kagan—the Justice allotted to the Circuit from which this case arose—denied my original application for a COA on May 3, 2022, in Application No. 21A671 (*See* Supreme Court docket entry at:

<https://www.supremecourt.gov/search.aspx?filename=/docket/docketfiles/html/public/21a671.html>). Under Supreme Court Rule 22.4, I request you to direct this renewed application for a COA to **Justice Gorsuch**.

Federal Rule of Appellate Procedure 22(b)(1) and 28 U.S.C. §2253(c)(1) does not limit COA applications to a single circuit justice. Thus, renewed application is permissible under Supreme Court Rule 22.4 once the justice allotted to the circuit from which the case arose denies the original application.

Since I am an indigent, pro se party confined to an institution, I am filing only an original as allowed by Supreme Court Rule 39.2.
