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To the Honorable Neil M. Gorsuch, Associate Justice of the Supreme Court of the United States and Circuit Justice for the Tenth Circuit:

Petitioner Michael James Bosman prays for a 30-day extension of time, to and including Monday, June 20, 2022, in which to file his petition for writ of certiorari. In support of this request, counsel states as follows:

1. On February 18, 2022, the United States Court of Appeals for the Tenth Circuit affirmed the judgment of the district court in this case. A copy of that opinion is an attachment to this application.

2. Mr. Bosman has ninety days from February 18 to petition for a writ of certiorari. Sup. Ct. R. 13.3. Ninety days from February 18 is May 19. This application is being filed at least ten days before May 19.

3. The jurisdiction of this Court is invoked under 28 U.S.C. § 1254(1).

4. I believe an extension of time will be needed adequately to prepare Mr. Bosman's petition for writ of certiorari. I have recently filed the reply brief in United States v. Smalley, No. 21-1167 (10th Cir.), and I will be filing the petition for writ of certiorari in United States v. Bullcoming, No. 20-6125 (10th Cir.), later this week. I am responsible for filing the reply brief in United States v. Dobosu, No. 21-1236 (10th Cir.), by

May 19, the day Mr. Bosman's petition is currently due, and I will be arguing Smalley before the Tenth Circuit on that day as well.

5. The requested extension is for thirty days. Because thirty days from May 19 is Saturday, June 18, the requested extension is until the next business day of Monday, June 20. See Sup. Ct. R. 30.1. During the requested extension period, I am also responsible for filing the opening briefs in United States v. Maloid, No. 21-1422 (10th Cir.), and United States v. Xian, No. 22-1030 (10th Cir.).

WHEREFORE Michael James Bosman respectfully requests that an order be entered extending his time in which to petition for certiorari by thirty days, to and including Monday, June 20, 2022.
