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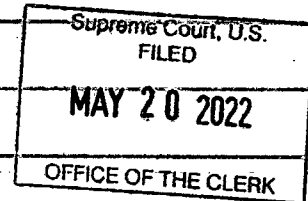

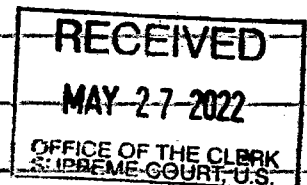

MOTION FOR EXTENTION OF TIME

Now comes the Petitioner, King Michael Oliver, in propria persona, hereby respectfully request for an extention of time to file Petition for Writ of Certiorari pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 13.5, in support thereof, I hereby assert the following;

1. I sincerely apologize to the Court, not because the extra time is sought and really needed but because I really believed that I had more time to file due to the Covid-19 related order extending the 90 day time limit to 150 days.

Upon inquiry, the library Clerk informed me that the Order had been rescinded. She also provided me with a document entitled "Guidance Concerning Clerk's Office Operations" which I have included in the Appendix. (A7-A9)

2. I really need more time to research in order to file a meaningful Petition in the Supreme Court especially since I have been denied on all previous levels for adequate law library time and the denial on the Appellate level caused me to be unable to file a reply brief in the judgement sought to be reviewed affirming dismissal by the United States District Court. (Order included in Appendix) (A1-A6)

3. Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. 1254 (1), the Supreme Court has the power to review virtually any decision of a federal court of appeals. I would like a fair opportunity to file a productive Petition and I respectfully request the Court to enter an order granting an extension of time.

4. The reasons for needing an extension have not changed from the ones that I have made previously to the District Court and the Appellate Court, therefore, it is more convenient to simply include those requests (Motions) in the Appendix in support of the request that I am making now and for the Court to review for decision making purposes. (See A10 - A13) (A14 - 17)

5. For good cause, pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 13.5, a Justice may extend the time to file a Petition for Writ of Certiorari for a period not exceeding 60 days.

WHEREFORE, I respectfully request an extension of 60 days within which to file a Petition for Writ of Certiorari to begin from the date of the Order.
