TO THE SECOND CIRCUIT.

To the Hon. Sonia Sotomayor, Circuit Justice for the Second
Circuit:

Petitioner John Crews, through Ines McGillion, Esq.,
appellate counsel appointed under the Criminal Justice Act, 18
U.S.C. § 3006A(d)(6), respectfully moves the Court pursuant to
Supreme Court Rules 13.5, 22, and 30.2 for an extension of 60
