PETITIONER'S APPLICATION FOR EXTENSION OF
TIME TO FILE A PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI
TO THE FIRST CIRCUIT.

To the Hon. Stephen Breyer, Circuit Justice for the First
Circuit:

Petitioner Douglas Norris, through Ines McGillion, Esq.,
appellate counsel appointed under the Criminal Justice Act, 18
U.S.C. § 3006A(d)(6), respectfully moves the Court pursuant to
Supreme Court Rules 13.5, 22, and 30.2 for an extension of 60
days, from July 28, 2022 to September 26, 2022, to file a *pro se*
petition for a writ of certiorari to review the First Circuit's
December 28, 2021 Opinion and Order affirming his conviction
and sentence and the April 29, 2022 Order denying his petition for

rehearing and rehearing on banc. The Court's jurisdiction is based on 28 U.S.C. § 1257.

The date on which a petition for writ of certiorari would otherwise be due, if not extended, is July 28, 2022. Petitioner is filing this June 10, 2022, more than a month before that date. See S. Ct. Rule 13.5. The extension is reasonably necessary to permit Mr. Norris to research, write, and submit a petition.
