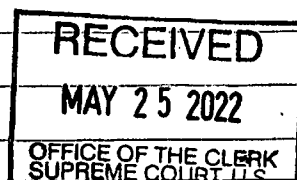

Petition For Waiver

Comes now Petitioner Eric Watkins files this
Petition For Waiver asking this Court to Waive
the Court's rules that requires Petitioner to
file a forty page Petition For Writ of Certiorari,
Ten copies of the Petition and Ten copies of the
Motion For leave to proceed in forma pauperis
and its supporting affidavit. Petitioner ask this
Court to allow him to only file his original
Petition For Writ of Certiorari, his original mot
ion for leave to proceed in forma pauperis and
its affidavit and to allow him to file his origi
al petition for writ of certiorari consisting of
forty four pages. In support Petitioner offers the
following:

① Pursuant to Petitioner's dire indigency, as demonstrated in Petitioner's motion to proceed in forma pauperis and its supporting affidavit, Petitioner cannot afford to purchase ten copies of his original petition for writ of Certiorari nor ten copies of his motion for leave to proceed in forma pauperis and its supporting affidavit. Petitioner's checking account is currently in the negative and he has no cash on hand and does not know when he would have the money to make the purchases of the copies.

At the least it would cost Petitioner, 15 cent per page at the library. Petitioner's petition, *supra*, consist of forty four pages plus nine pages that consist of the cover page plus eight other pages that is not counted as petition pages. This equals 53 pages. Then the motion for leave to proceed in forma pauperis and its supporting affidavit consist of six pages. This totals 59 pages. One copy would cost Petitioner \$8.85 plus taxes and \$8.50 for ten copies. Petitioner does not have this money and pursuant to Petitioner's expense that for Oct Lawrence his earnings Petitioner does not know when he would have the \$88.50.

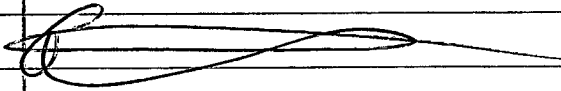
② Due to Petitioner's Laquarship in the sciences of the American Jurisprudence and concise legal writing and his lack of the skill of typing and computer literacy Petitioner has not

been able to write his petition for writ of certiorari within the allowed 40 page limit. Petitioner went over the 40 page limit by four pages. Neither does Petitioner have the money to pay for his petition to be typed.

For the reasons stated above Petitioner ask this Court to grant this petition for ~~waiver~~ in its entirety.

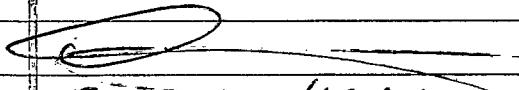
