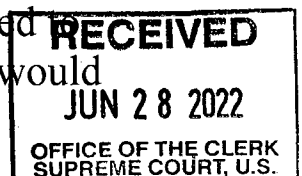
RE: Request for extension of time to file petition for a writ of certiorari Sen v. Amazon.com, Inc. Ninth Circuit Case No. 20-55857

I am a pro se litigant on this case. According to the online docket and pursuant to Rule 13.1 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of the United States the time to submit my writ of certiorari is on or before Jun 28, 2022.

Attached is the copy of Southern California District Court Dismissal Decision, Ninth Circuit Affirmation and Ninth Circuit Hearing Decision.

Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2101(c) and Rule 13.5 of the Rules of this Court I respectfully request that the time for filing a response be extended by 60 days, to and including August 27, 2022. As a petitioner this is my first request for an extension of time to file the petition. Good cause exists for the requested extension. Since I am a pro se litigant and do not have the sufficient financial and legal resources, do not know the Supreme Court procedures it requires extra time to familiarize myself and complete on my petition for writ of certiorari. I am late for asking extension of time because of my inexperience. I misjudged the time needs to be allocated to complete the petition satisfactorily. An extension of time would



better enable preparation of a writ of certiorari that would be most helpful.
