Petitioner asks this motion be filed late, as three times petitioner requested Extension of time. All were denied. (June 8th and Aug 4th and Oct 22, 2021.)

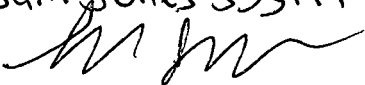
