RE: Request for extension of briefing deadlines in Sylvia Gonzalez v. Edward Trevino, et al., No. 22-1025

Dear Mr. Harris:

I write on behalf of all parties to request an extension of the briefing deadlines in this case. The Court granted the petition for a writ of certiorari on October 13, 2023. I understand that the case is likely to be argued during the Court's February 2024 or March 2024 sitting. Petitioner's opening merits brief is currently due November 27, 2023. Respondents' opening merits brief is currently due December 27, 2023. On behalf of all parties, I respectfully request, under this Court's Rule 30.4, that Petitioner's time to file her opening brief and any joint appendix be extended by 14 days to and including December 11, 2023, and that Respondents' time to file their brief be extended by 14 days to and including January 10, 2024. Under this Court's rules, Petitioner's reply brief would be due 30 days later, which is more than 10 days before the earliest possible argument during the February 2024 sitting.

Counsel for both parties request these extensions of time.
