Dear Mr. Harris:

I write on behalf of all parties to modify the previous request for an extension of the briefing deadlines. The Court granted the petition for a writ of certiorari on October 13, 2023. I understand that the case is likely to be argued during the Court's February or March 2024 sitting. Petitioner's opening merits brief is currently due November 27, 2023. Respondents' opening merits brief is currently due December 27, 2023.

On behalf of all parties, I respectfully request, under this Court's Rule 30.4, that Petitioner's time to file her opening brief and any joint appendix be extended to and including December 11, 2023, and that Respondents' time to file their brief be extended to and including January 24, 2024. Under this Court's rules, Petitioner's reply brief would be due 30 days later on February 23, 2024, unless the Court schedules argument before the March sitting.

Counsel for both parties request these extensions of time.
