Dear Mr. Harris:

Pursuant to Rule 21.4, please allow this letter to serve as Petitioners' response to the request of Elise Brown to extend the time to respond to the Petition for Writ of Certiorari ("Petition"). The Petition for Writ of Certiorari, filed on May 8, 2023, challenges the Ninth Circuit's denial of qualified immunity to Petitioners Officer Matthew Gregory and Madalyn Briley (collectively, "Petitioner") on Ms. Brown's excessive force claim against Petitioners.

Petitioners oppose the request to extend the time to respond to the Petition. On July 28, 2023, a response was requested by August 28, 2023. On August 22, 2023, Ms. Brown's counsel requested a 30-day extension, which was granted to September 27, 2023. Ms. Brown now requests another 30-day extension to October 27, 2023.

Trial on the excessive force claim is scheduled to proceed in the District Court, however, on October 10, 2023, and an extension of time would prohibit the Justices' consideration of the Petition before trial. As a result, Petitioners ask that the request for an extension be denied.
