Two of the individuals who were trustees during the lower court proceedings (Michael H. Holland and Joseph R. Reschini) are no longer trustees and have been replaced by other individuals (Michael W. Buckner and Paul B. Piccolini). Any interest that Mr. Holland and Mr. Reschini had in this case has passed to their successors, Mr. Buckner and Mr. Piccolini.

In addition, after the Eleventh Circuit decision in this case, the petitioners settled with JW Window Components LLC. As a result of that settlement, JW Window Components LLC no longer has any interest in this case.
