Dear Mr. Harris:

I represent respondent X Corp. (successor in interest to Twitter, Inc.) in the above-referenced case. The petition for a writ of certiorari was filed in this case on June 8, 2023 and docketed on June 12, 2023. On July 26, 2023, the Court requested a response to the petition by August 25, 2023.

Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30.4, respondent respectfully requests that the Court extend the time for X Corp. to file a brief in opposition to the petition by 30 days, up to and including September 25, 2023. The extension is requested because the current deadline overlaps with deadlines that counsel for X Corp. have in other cases over the coming weeks and counsel's long-planned travel throughout the month of August. In addition, counsel has been notified that at least one non-party intends to file an amicus brief in support of the petition. The requested extension would better enable preparation of a response that would be helpful to the Court.
