Dear Mr. Harris:

I am counsel for the respondent in this case. Petitioner filed its petition of certiorari on June 30, 2022. According to the online docket and pursuant to Rule 15.3 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of the United States, a response is currently due on August 5, 2022. Pursuant to Rule 30.4, respondent respectfully requests that the time for filing a response be extended by 10 days, to and including August 15, 2022.

This is respondent's first request for an extension of time to file a response, and good cause exists for the requested extension. Yesterday, respondent consented to the filing of an amicus brief, which pursuant to Rule 37.2(a) is due on August 5, 2022, the same day as Respondent's brief in opposition to the petition is currently due. Respondent wishes to review the amicus brief before filing its brief in opposition. Moreover, I will be in Europe from August 5, 2022 until August 9, 2022 on a long-planned family vacation.
