Respondent, California State Law Enforcement Association (“CSLEA”), filed a waiver of the right to respond to the petition for a writ of certiorari in this case. The waiver was received by this Court on September 29, 2022. On November 2, 2022, this Court requested a response to the petition. The response is presently due on December 2, 2022. On November 14, 2022, pursuant to Rule 30.4, Respondents the Attorney General of California and the California State Controller (the “State Respondents”) filed a request for an extension of time to file their response until January 3, 2023.

Respondent CSLEA respectfully joins the State Respondents’ request to extend the time to file its response to January 3, 2023. If this Court grants the State Respondents’ request, it is efficient to extend CSLEA’s time as well so that the parties’ briefing schedules are aligned. Like the State Respondents, counsel for Respondent CSLEA face a number of time constraints in the upcoming weeks, including: depositions, various briefing deadlines on substantive merits-based motions, hearings, and travel for the Thanksgiving holiday.

Respondent CSLEA therefore respectfully requests an extension to January 3, 2023, to ensure there is sufficient time to provide a response that would be the most helpful to this Court.
