Nieveen v. TAX 106, No. 22-237 - Motion to Extend Time to File Brief in

Opposition to Petition for a Writ of Certiorari

Dear Mr. Harris:

Respondents respectfully request an extension of time to file their briefs in opposition to the petition for a writ of certiorari in this case. Counsel for all Respondents have authorized Douglas J. Peterson, Attorney General of the State of Nebraska, to speak for them in this letter. Respondents ask that the deadline for the briefs in opposition be extended from November 25, 2022, to December 6, 2022.

This extension request is justified for the following reasons. First, the petition in this case closely tracks the petition filed in *Fair v. Continental Resources*, No. 22-160, and the briefs in opposition in that case are due December 2. General Peterson will be filing briefs in both cases, so to ensure that he has adequate time for both briefs, he asks to move the deadline in this case after the deadline in that case. Second, Respondents' counsel have had many other pressing litigation tasks and deadlines demanding their time over the last few weeks, and they continue to have more throughout the next few weeks.
