Dear Mr. Harris:

Pursuant to Rule 30.4, Respondents David L. de Csepel, Angela Maria Herzog and Julia Alice Herzog (“Respondents”), through their undersigned counsel, respectfully request a 30-day extension of time to respond to the Petition for a Writ of Certiorari (the “Petition”) filed by Petitioners Museum of Fine Arts, Hungarian National Gallery, Museum of Applied Arts, Budapest University of Technology and Economics and Magyar Nemzeti Vagyongazdálkodási Zrt. (“Petitioners”).

The original deadline for filing the Petition was August 8, 2022. Petitioners requested an extension of time to file until September 7, 2022. Chief Justice Roberts granted that request and Petitioners filed the Petition on September 7, 2022. The Petition was placed on the docket on September 14, 2022. Respondents’ opposition is currently due on October 14, 2022.

In light of counsel’s other commitments, including motion practice in this matter which is proceeding in the district court, and the limited availability of certain attorneys during the Jewish holidays this month, Respondents require an extension of time to sufficiently address the issues relevant to the Court’s decision to grant or deny the Petition. Respondents therefore respectfully request a 30-day extension of time, up to and including Monday November 14, 2022, within which to file their Brief in Opposition to the Petition.

No party will be prejudiced by the extension requested herein. Counsel for Petitioners, Mr. Thaddeus J. Stauber, has confirmed that Petitioners do not oppose this request.
